
RESOLUTION

At a meeting of the Public Health Leaders Roundtable on March 31, 2009, the following resolution was proposed and unanimously approved by all members:

The members of the Public Health Leaders Roundtable would like to commend Congressman Jim McGovern (D-MA), Congresswoman Kay Granger (R-TX) and Congresswoman Lucille Roybal-Allard (D-CA) for their critical letter to appropriators requesting an increase in funding for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in fiscal year 2010. We applaud these members of Congress for their wise and truly bipartisan leadership on behalf of the nation's health protection and disease prevention efforts. The letter, open to signature by other colleagues in Congress until April 3, 2009, asks for a much-needed \$2 billion increase to the CDC's core program budget lines.
