



RESOLUTION

At a meeting of the Public Health Leaders Roundtable on March 31, 2009, the following resolution was proposed and unanimously approved by all members:

The members of the Public Health Leaders Roundtable would like to express their gratitude to Georgia state Senators Renee Unterman, Don Thomas, Cecil Stanton, Lee Hawkins, Judson Hill and Preston Smith for introducing Senate Resolution 263 last month that called for an increase in federal support for public health programs in the state. The resolution, which was subsequently adopted by the Senate, details the myriad public health activities undertaken by the public health workforce in Georgia and outlines the need for an increase in funding for these essential prevention and wellness programs. As fellow public health advocates we applaud their efforts to bring to light the critical importance of adequate funding for public health.
